The Department of Tourism and Service Management is seeking an outstanding scholar to conduct research and to teach in the area of tourism information technology and digitalization. This is a **full-time, five-years** tenure-track position with the **possibility for promotion to an unlimited Associate Professor or Senior Lecturer position after successful evaluation**. Applicants are prepared to work **40 hours per week**.

Responsibilities

- Independent basic research in the area of tourism information technology, digitalization, machine learning, artificial intelligence and contributing to research and teaching (undergraduate and graduate courses) within the scope of the department (<https://www.modul.ac.at/about/departments/tourism-and-service-management/research-focus/>).
- Conducting and acquiring third party funded research projects and knowledge transfer services of approx. 200 hours per year.
- Teaching and conducting examinations independently (the teaching load for this position is 5 units/week per semester (1 unit = 45 minutes of teaching). The teaching load comprises time for supervising undergraduate and master thesis.
- Administrative and academic services.

Desired Qualifications

- A doctorate with a specialization in tourism and/or information technology, statistics or a related field and an outstanding average grade on your university degree.
- Candidates ideally have a proven track record of teaching experience, scholarly publications and a high potential for generating research funding.
- Experience with quantitative research methods and statistical software packages.

- A strong research interest in technology in a travel, tourism, hospitality, or service management context.
- Fluent in the English language.

Salary and Application Process

The initial salary is EUR 55,000 before taxes (plus approximately 30% employer's contribution to social security), with additional remuneration for extra teaching, generating third party research funds and outstanding scholarship. The position remains open until filled; the review of applications will commence immediately.
